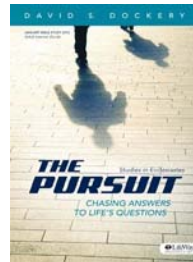

HOW TO JOIN ASH AVENUE BAPTIST CHURCH

Requirements:
